At BOE, our philosophy is simple: we believe in the transformative power of outdoor education to create lasting, positive change in students' lives.

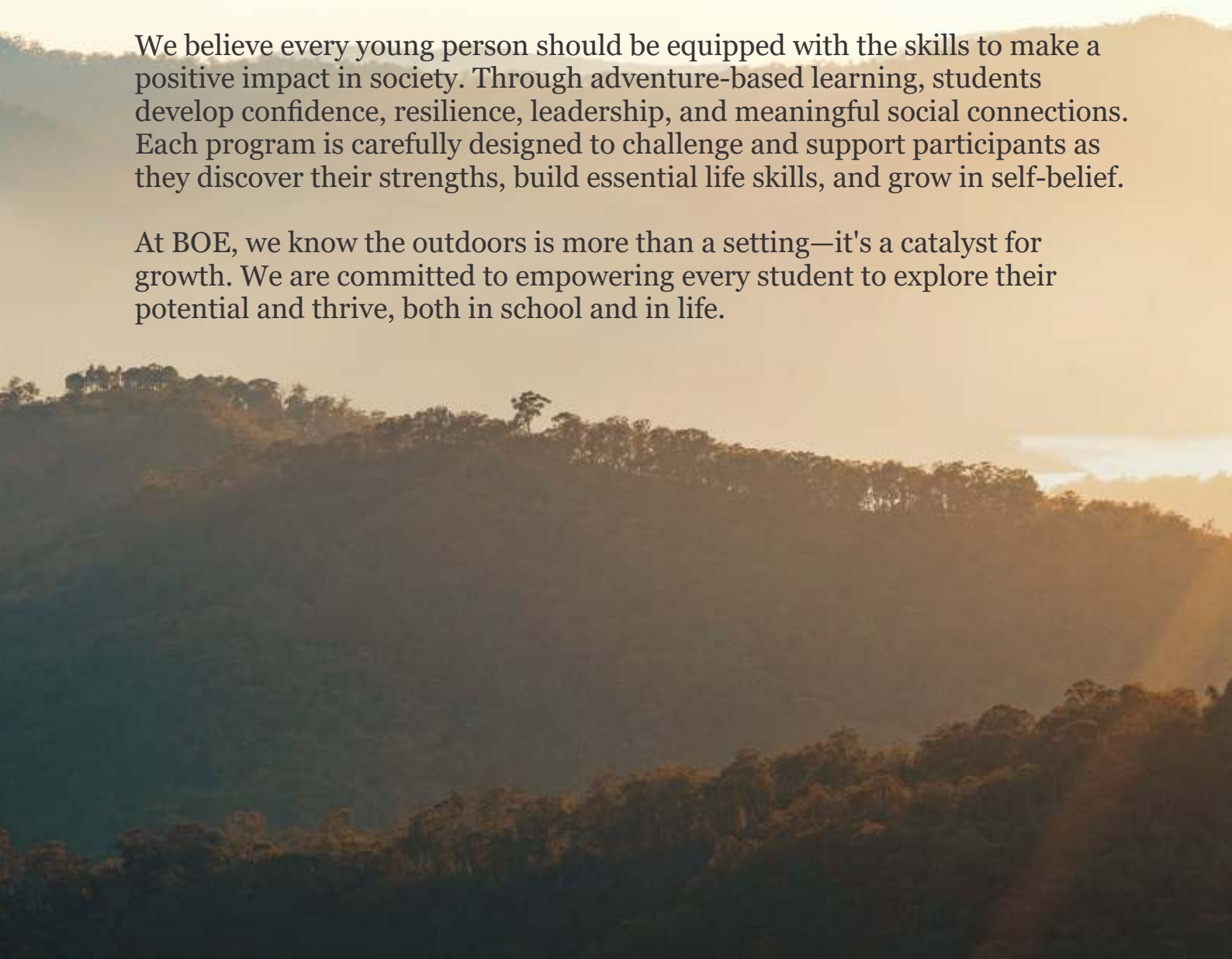

THE BRIARS CAMP, VICTORIA

SPARK CURIOSITY AND A LOVE FOR NATURE

Tucked away in the heart of The Briars Conservation Park in Mount Martha, Victoria, our 15-acre camp provides a magical natural setting perfect for young explorers. At our camp, children can dive into a world of adventure and environmental activities, designed to spark curiosity and a love for nature.

Positioned ideally within the Mornington Peninsula, we're just a stone's throw away from enchanting woodland paths and soothing beachfront walks. This special place isn't just a camp—it's a launchpad for lifelong memories and discoveries in the great outdoors, making every day an exciting journey for our young campers.



MT BUFFALO CHALET, VICTORIA

WHERE NATURE, HISTORY AND ADVENTURE COLLIDE

Perched high above the iconic Gorge and surrounded by the dramatic alpine landscapes of Mount Buffalo National Park, the Mt Buffalo Chalet offers a unique environment where students can immerse themselves in nature, history, and adventure. Rising 1,723 metres above sea level and home to breathtaking rock formations, hidden waterways, and panoramic views, Mount Buffalo provides a powerful backdrop for learning and exploration.

Programs delivered here focus on environmental understanding, personal growth, and building a deeper connection to the alpine landscape. Students are encouraged to learn through hands on experiences, engaging with conservation efforts, local wildlife, and the unique ecosystems of the plateau—fostering stewardship and inspiring a lifelong appreciation for the natural world.



CAMP EILDON, VICTORIA

SELF DISCOVERY AND CONNECTION

Located just two hours from Melbourne and set along the banks of the Goulburn River, Camp Eildon offers an immersive outdoor education experience designed to guide self-discovery and exploration. Surrounded by the Australian bush, students step into a semi-remote environment where fewer amenities and new surroundings encourage them to stretch their comfort zones and engage deeply with the world around them.

Programs at Camp Eildon focus on building communication, collaboration and social cohesion as students move between two dynamic sites connected by overnight bushwalking, camping and cycling. Our site features tented accommodation, a small dining hall, low ropes course, overwater initiatives and access to one of the best paddling sections of the Goulburn River. The second site, Wanggai, a brilliant high ropes course, open bushland and excellent mountain biking trails—providing immersive, hands-on learning experiences that help students recognise their strengths and see new possibilities in themselves and others.



CAMP MARGARET RIVER, Western Australia

YOUR GATEWAY TO THE CAPES

Camp Margaret River is nestled amongst towering Karri trees, along the limestone ridge that stretches between the north and south capes.

Onsite we have high and low ropes courses, a sensory trail and walking access to the pristine white sandy beach and clear blue water of Hamelin Bay. Our unique location also allows easy access to canoeing, abseiling, caving, the surrounding forests and worldclass Cape to Cape Track.

Our facility allows us to provide supported introductions to outdoor education programs, or, can be used to launch a more independent journey-style program, giving us a range of options to develop student outcomes and create both sequenced and standalone experiences.

We also operate at hardtop, residential camps throughout the state, allowing us to deliver a range of experiences tailored to meet your needs.

FOOD AND CATERING

Our camp programs are jointly facilitated, offering teachers the opportunity to engage closely with students in a supervisory and pastoral care capacity. Teachers are encouraged to join in activities, providing a great opportunity to build rapport with students.

RISK MANAGEMENT

As leaders in outdoor education, risk management is at the heart of everything that we do at BOE; before, during and after program. A continual focus on risk management procedures and research results in all programs having robust strategies and systems in place to ensure, as far as reasonably practicable, the safety of all; staff, participants, and others who are associated with our programs.

A dedicated Risk, Safety and Compliance team is responsible for researching best practices from around the world, tracking and reviewing incidents, informing training, updating policies and maintaining our Administrative Practices and Field Practices Manuals, that define our operating guidelines and standards. Our standards also align with Australian Adventure Activity Standards (AAAS).

We take a systems-based approach to managing risk and work to embed best practices at every step of program preparation, delivery, and review.

FIELD DUTY MANAGER

Our dedicated 24/7 Field Duty Manager is always on call, providing real-time support to teams in the field. This ensures risks are managed proactively, decision making is backed by experience, and every program is supported with confidence and care.
